



Classification, Labelling and Packaging: your legal obligations

1 day interactive workshop

This course is designed to introduce you to the new Classification, Labelling and Packaging (CLP) Regulation (Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008) which sets-out the new requirements for the classification, labelling and packaging of chemical substances and mixtures. The Regulation came into force on 20 January 2009 and some requirements impact on businesses immediately whilst others come into effect in the future. The CLP Regulation implements the Globally Harmonised System for the classification and labelling of chemicals (GHS) in the EU.

The course is presented by Andrew Fasey who was a member of the IOMC (Inter-Organisational programme for the sound Management of Chemicals) drafting group which prepared the GHS and also represented the UK and the European Commission at the UN SCEGHS (United Nations Sub-Committee of Experts on the GHS). He was also responsible in the European Commission for preparing the ground for the implementation of the GHS in the EU. He is currently a Training Advisor to UNITAR (the UN Institute for Training and Research) on the global implementation of the GHS and also works with a number of companies to help them prepare effectively and efficiently for the implementation of CLP.
