



SVHCs and REACH

1/2 day interactive workshop

SVHCs (Substances of Very High Concern) are a diverse group of substances that have been placed on the Candidate List for Authorisation by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) because of their particularly hazardous properties. REACH imposes specific controls on SVHCs over and above those that apply to other chemicals.

This workshop will provide chemical users and suppliers of articles with all the information they need to comply with REACH in respect of SVHC and to assess the business and commercial impact of these substances. The workshop will provide up-to-date and accurate information on REACH requirements for SVHCs, together with practical advice on compliance and management that can be applied by the participants in their own business setting.
