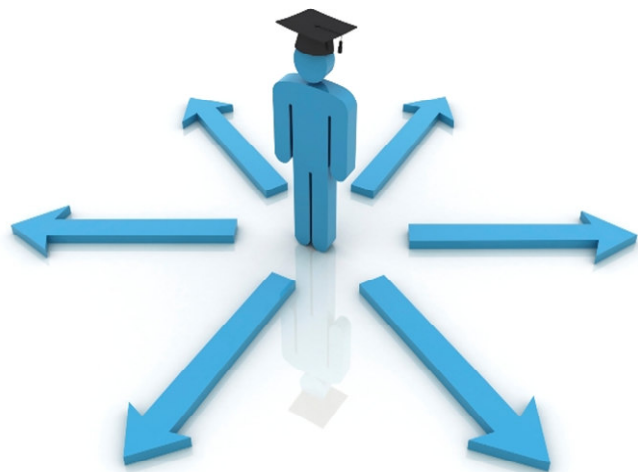


# REACH Management for Chemical Users
