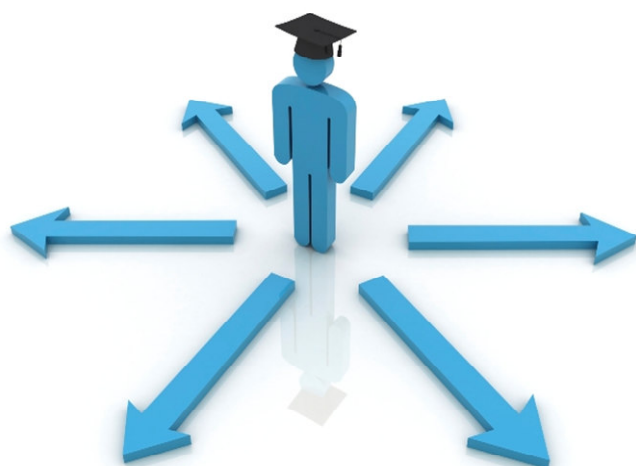


# Managing REACH: practical help for potential registrants
