

Data Acquisition and Management



The REACH Centre offers a flexible range of data acquisition and management services and we act as a central point of contact for organisations seeking to assemble or generate data for registration purposes.

Typical areas where this service would be useful include:

- The acquisition and/or submission of data for registration
- PBT and vPvB assessments
- Obtaining and compiling data for Exposure Scenarios

Who would benefit from this service

- Non-consortium members requiring information, data and access to testing
- Lead Registrants, Only Representatives and SIEF members
- Organisations considering the introduction of new substances or the substitution of others at some future date
- Organisations in which the skill base or availability of effort hinders REACH related activities

Options available

Our aim is to provide the appropriate level of support and guidance to suit each individual organisation's needs and to facilitate this, we offer a number of service options. An outline of what each package offers is shown below.

Tier 1 - Primary information package

- A detailed literature search
- A bibliography of relevant references or other data sources
- Where the generation of primary data is necessary, a list of organisations offering the appropriate testing services and their contact details

Tier 2 - Overview package

- A detailed literature search
- An assessment of the relevant output
- Brief abstracts of key literature articles and preliminary guidance
- Where the generation of primary data is necessary, a list of organisations offering the appropriate testing services and their contact details

Tier 3 - Full package

- A full assessment of existing data and subsequent gap analysis to identify requirements
- A detailed review of all relevant available literature data
- Where required, coordination of all necessary outstanding testing
- A full interpretation of test results and data validation
