

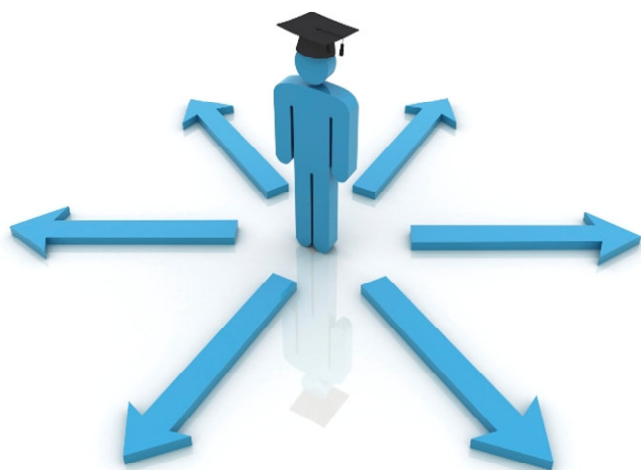
# SIEFs: Understanding the essentials

## Half-day interactive workshop
