

Third Party Representative

Pre-registrants of phase-in substances will be able to appoint a third party representative when they make the pre-registration. Whilst the manufacturer or importer making the pre-registration retains full responsibility for his obligations under the Regulation the third party representative will represent that business in all matters associated with Title III (Data Sharing) of the Regulation. Importantly whilst the identity of the pre-registrant is known to the Agency other pre-registrants of the same substances together with other members (data holders) of the substance information exchange forum (SIEF) for the substance will see only the third party's identity not that of the pre-registrant.

The role of the SIEF is to prepare a joint hazard data set for the substance, agree where possible the classification and labelling of the substances. They are expected to share test data related to the hazard assessment and to jointly share the costs of any new testing required. SIEF members may also work together in carrying out a chemical safety assessment (CSA) and preparing a chemical safety report (CSR)
